SUBJECT: Notice of Availability of Final Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact for Proposed Construction and Operation of a Community-Based Outpatient Clinic in Bakersfield, California

Dear Valued Stakeholder:

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has prepared a Final Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for a Proposed Action to construct and operate a community-based outpatient clinic east of Knudsen Street, west of Landco Drive, north of Hageman Road, and south of Olive Drive in Bakersfield, CA. The purpose of this Proposed Action is to provide a modern, state-of-the-art medical facility to serve Veterans in Bakersfield and surrounding communities. The Proposed Action is needed to address current and future projected health care needs of Veterans in Kern County.
