## VA State Home Construction Grant Program Overview



#### **State Home Construction Grant Program**

- The State Home Construction Grant Program is a partnership between VA and state agencies to construct, renovate, or upgrade state-owned and operated nursing homes, domiciliaries, and/or adult day health care facilities. For a SHCGP grant, VA may reimburse applicants up to 65% of the cost of a project, pursuant to 38 CFR § 59.80(a).
- At present, there are 170 active SVHs nationwide.
- None have been yet been built and operated by a Tribe, but the Isakson and Roe Veterans Health Care and Benefits Improvement Act of 2020 amended the statutory authority of the SHCGP to include Indian Tribes in the definition of "state" and "state home."

# Need for a Nationwide Programmatic Agreement



#### **COVID-19 Pandemic**

- Nursing homes, including SVHs, were particularly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- During the COVID-19 pandemic, Congress provided VA with emergency funds to help SVHs install infection-control measures, upgrade safety systems, and improve infrastructure, resulting in dozens of emergency consultation efforts.
- The ACHP recommended development of a program alternative to follow during a healthcare crisis, especially when VA serves as a grantor of federal funds to non-federal applicants.



#### **Opportunities for Clarity**

- Procedures in a healthcare emergency
  - Reduction in number of expedited consultation requests
- Agency roles/responsibilities
  - Grantor of funds not facility operator
- Applicant roles/responsibilities
  - Best design practices
- Differences in emergencies
  - Human
  - Natural
  - Long-term health-related




# Goals of a Nationwide Programmatic Agreement

#### **Applicability**

- Limited to SHCGP
- Use of agreement does not guarantee award of VA funds
- States and Tribes are not required to use SHCGP funds to build SVHs
- Would not apply when National Historic Landmarks are within the APE

#### **Proposed Exemption for Renovations**

- Building is forty (40) years of age or less (i.e., constructed after 1984) or has been determined not historic through consultation with respective SHPO &
- Undertaking is limited to the interior of the building and/or
- Undertaking involves exterior modifications but there are no historic properties within the **APE**



#### **Flexibility in Timelines**

**Exempted Actions** 

No change

**Ongoing Pandemic** 

Retention of seven (7) day review for rehabilitation and renovation undertakings

Use of 30-day review for proposed demolitions, facility replacements, and construction of new facilities

Emergency/Disaster Recovery

Expansion of the 30-day schedule to 90 days


